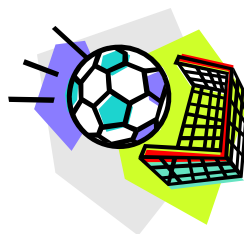

The Wausau West Soccer Camp Philosophy

Local player development is the cornerstone of the Wausau West Soccer Camp. " **I believe that in order for the programs in our area to be successful, we have a responsibility to work with young local players in the community so that one day they will possibly possess the skills necessary to contribute to the high school level and to the college level for the players who aspire to go to that level.**" Coach Wavrunek Said.

The Camp will be held at the Wausau West High School Soccer Fields. Registration will take place at 1:30 P.M. on the first day of camp at the Field House at Wausau West High School (gym). The camp will utilize all of the practice and game facilities. The camp will never be cancelled due to inclement weather. Indoor areas will be used on the bad weather days.

Teaching of technical skill needed to play will be each day's objective. Players learn these skills in a competitive but fun manner that is easy to understand. For the younger ages we will be focusing on the fun of the game. The exercises used to teach these skills parallel game situations in small sided games and scrimmages. The main ingredient of the camp is fun. Teaching groups will be determined by age and skill level to the best of our ability.
